Schoolwide Learning Expectations for Students Entering 2nd Grade

Christians:

- Be an active, reverent participant in weekly Masses and Religion class
- Recite the following prayers: Sign of the Cross, Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be and Prayer before Meals
- Demonstrate a Christian spirit when dealing with peers and teachers

Learners:

Reading Language Arts:

- Write legibly using appropriate lines and spaces
- Read the first 100 Fry high-frequency sight words fluently
- Demonstrate the following phonemic awareness tasks: rhyming, phoneme segmentation (c/a/t), sound/letter relationship and basic phonetic spelling (kid spelling)
- Show a basic understanding of author, illustrator, character and setting
- Demonstrate a basic knowledge of beginning, middle and end of a story
- Produce a complete sentence with attention to punctuation and capitalization

Math:

- Count and write fluently to 100, and skip count
- Tell time to the hour
- Perform basic addition
- Identify basic shapes and patterns
- Use problem-solving strategies to solve simple addition or subtraction story problems
- Identify and know the value of a penny and a dime
- Demonstrate a basic understanding of calendar concepts (months, seasons, dates, days of the week)

Homework:

- Show an interest in being responsible for their own homework, planner and class materials
- Have a nightly expectation of 20 minutes of reading and 20 minutes of homework
- Produce their own quality homework

Communicators:

- Be an active listener
- Speak kindly and respect the ideas of others
- Raise their hand to ask questions or make comments
- Work cooperatively with peers

Citizens:

- Follow multi-step instructions and transition from subject to subject with ease
- Be respectful of teachers, students and property
- Demonstrate an understanding of school rules and classroom expectations
- Take responsibility for their own actions
