Schoolwide Learning Expectations for Students Entering 5th Grade

Christians:

- Recite Memorized Prayers of the Rosary
- Demonstrate knowledge of Catholic teachings, Sacraments and Ten Commandments
- Identify and understand the parts of the Mass
- Demonstrate understanding of Catholic social teaching and apply these principles to social and personal situations
- Demonstrate understanding of the Liturgical year and how it is celebrated
- Understand service to the community (family, parish, local, national and global) as response to the Gospel call

Learners:

- Rapid recall and fluency of multiplication, division, subtraction and addition facts
- Fluency in multiplying multi-digit whole numbers
- Demonstrate understanding of place value, fractions and fractions to decimals
- Compare and order whole numbers, simple fractions and decimals to hundredths
- Familiarity with geometry and geometric terminology
- Understand mathematical language and symbols
- Determine measurements using appropriate tools and formulas
- Write in cursive legibly and neatly
- Demonstrate knowledge of 4th grade sight words, syllable breaks, alphabetizing, dictionary skills, capitalization, homonyms, plurals and word families
- Read and comprehend at instructional level based on assessment
- Experience with book reports and familiarity with figurative language and genre
- Know four types of sentences (interrogative, declarative, statement and exclamatory)
- Identify simple/complete subject/predicate of a sentence
- Use capitalization, commas and quotation marks
- Identify parts of speech (noun, verb, pronoun, adverb, adjective and conjunction)
- Understand Six Traits of Writing
- Demonstrate Paragraph Writing – introduction, supporting details and conclusion

Communicators:

- Demonstrate oral and written skills
- Use sentence responses – rephrase correctly, include details and evaluate response
- Engage in range of discussions, paraphrase, identify reasons and evidence and report on a topic

Citizens:

- Recognize and practice good manners (thank you, holding doors, etc.)
- Listen, follow directions, practice self-control, and follow school and classroom rules
- Respect others individuals, school and personal property
- Avoid excessive absences and tardiness where possible
- Take responsibility/show accountability for actions
- Follow SJBE's mission and philosophy despite religious preferences
- Expect homework nightly, use daily planner, check Power School often
