Schoolwide Learning Expectations for Students Entering Kindergarten

Christians:

- Display Christian attitude (show kindness and compassion in words and actions)
- Respect for other children
- Respect for authority (teachers, ParaEducators, parent volunteers)
- Common courtesy (please, thank you, you're welcome, table manners)

Learners:

- Print awareness (print has meaning)
- Recognize own name
- Experience with pencils, scissors, glue and crayons
- Hold pencil correctly
- Print first name in capital (uppercase) letters
- Book orientation (identifies top, bottom, front and back of book)
- Recognize some letters and some sounds.
- Count to 30
- Recognize basic shapes (circle, square, rectangle and triangle)
- Recognize numbers 0-10
- Able to create a simple pattern
- Know 9 basic colors (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, black, brown and white)
- Read 20 minutes with parents

Communicators:

- Speak in complete sentences
- Can express self verbally with someone other than parents
- Follow two-step directions

Citizens:

- Separate from parents with ease
- Can play and interact with other children
- Can clean up after themselves
- Can independently perform personal tasks (putting on coat, socks, shoes, boots, buttons, zippers, pants, etc.)
- Respect for property
