- 2) HISPANIC CULTURE (dances, food recipes, and visits from native speakers).

- 4) Practice conversations with other campers, teachers, and teacher assistants.
- 5) Examine authentic materials, such as videos, commercials, music, cartoons, money, magazines, and much more!
- 6) Participate in a fiesta including Hispanic food and customs on Friday.
- 7) Spanish songs and games.

This is the first time that Spanish Camp will be offered at Saint John the Baptist Elementary. With the growing number of Spanish-speakers in the United States, this camp is an excellent opportunity to review what your child has learned or introduce new students to the Spanish language and culture!
